Catering Service

Starting in the new academic, we will have new caterers on site. Hutchisons are bringing an exciting new take on school dinners and we are looking forward to this new meals after the summer break.

We are currently experiencing issues with the machines that allow students to add money to their canteen accounts in school. This means that, at times, the machines will not accept the student's account numbers meaning they cannot add money in this way. This is an issue that we are not able to resolve until the summer holidays.

In the meantime, we do encourage parents use ParentPay to put money on to student accounts as this is the easiest and safest way to ensure that money is paid on. For those wishing to use cash, we are able to facilitate this over the remaining two weeks. If students take an envelope with their money to reception, with their name and pin number on the front, we will forward this to the kitchen, making sure these funds will be added by the end of the day. This will only be in place until the end of term and only for school dinners.

Further to this, could we also ask that any accounts that are in arrears are settled before the end of the year in light of this change of provider.
