

Co-Curricular Statement

Co-curricular provision at Hodgson seeks to engage our students in exciting, challenging and competitive activities that compliment the learning taking place in curriculum hours. We provide a range of opportunities designed to enable every student to develop intellectual curiosity, resilience, creativity, leadership qualities and a love of learning.

Co-Curricular Procedures

- Students attending co-curricular activities should arrive at the activity location promptly, bring any necessary equipment required and adhere to the academies behaviour expectations of PAUSE and CARE.
- It is the student's responsibility to ensure that parents/guardians are informed of their attendance. There will be no requirement to 'sign up' in advance unless stated otherwise.
- It is the responsibility of the student to take ownership of their personal organisation for co-curricular activities, including: location, time, staff, equipment and communication
 Channels.
- In the event of the fire alarm being activated, they follow the instructions of the staff member supervising the activity immediately.
- The co-curricular programme will change on a half-termly basis and will be communicated through the school website, social media, via form tutors, teachers, half termly emails and visual aids across the academy.
- Student attendance will be recorded by the lead teacher of each activity via Arbor. Students attending co-curricular clubs will be awarded house points at each session, as well as awards for participation and leadership at regular intervals in the academic calendar.











Co-Curricular Procedures

- Students must attend the full duration of the activity and not leave on their own accord, remaining actively involved at their very best.
- Students may not access mobile phones or valuables until after the co-curricular activity is finished and off the academy site.
- Students representing the school in competitive activities will receive additional guidance and information from the activity lead.
- All after school co-curricular activities will finish by 16.00 unless otherwise stated.
- In the rare event an activity is cancelled or postponed, the activity lead will contact parents/ guardians via email as soon as they can.
- Students should attend with a positive mindset, eager to learn, enjoy new experiences and maintain our academy motto of *Imagine, Believe, Achieve* in all that we do.
- Sports teams and academy representatives will be selected from attendance and ability at
 co-curricular clubs every half term. There is a carousel of inter school sports competitions
 throughout the academic year. Students and parents will be given further information on
 teams and schools fixtures periodically throughout the year.
