

Hodgson Academy has an attendance target for each academic year of 98%

At Hodgson, we know that school attendance is vital. If you regularly attend Hodgson, you have a fantastic chance of achieving outstanding results. If you were to achieve 90% in an exam, you would be really pleased, but in relation to attendance, below 90% registers you as persistently absent and will have a huge impact on your attainment.

In 2017, students who were persistently absent achieved 3 pass grades fewer than students who were top attenders. Similarly, the year before, persistently absent students achieved 5 fewer pass grades! Hodgson is an outstanding school with outstanding outcomes, but attendance in all secondary schools has a huge impact.

Academic Year 2016/2017



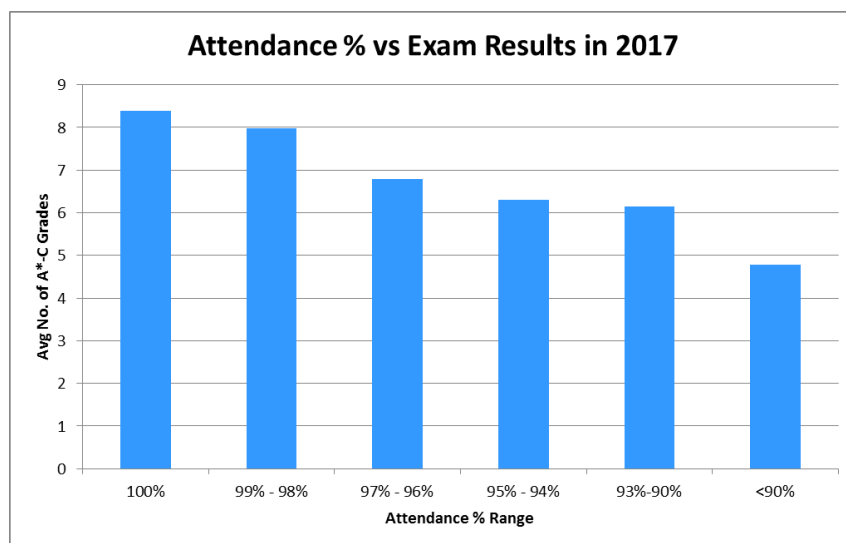
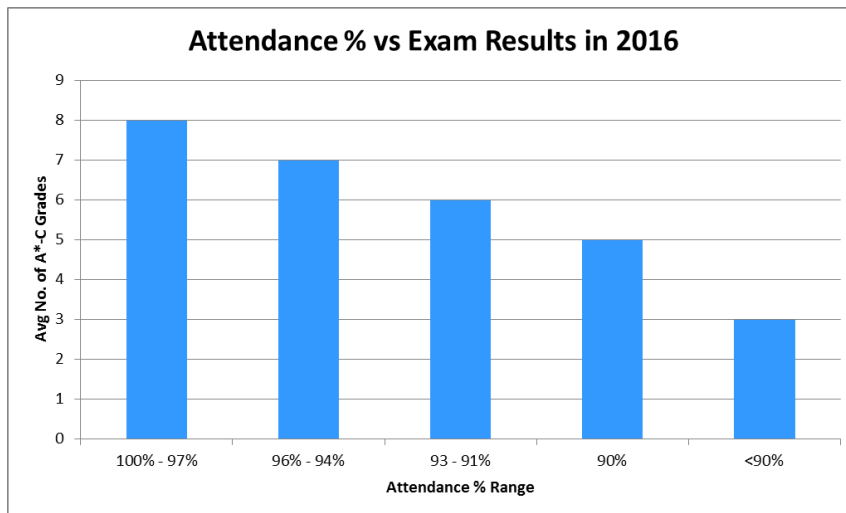
Whole School Attendance – 96.7%
